Meet us in Kansas City - where everything is up to date! As the largest city in the state of Missouri, Kansas City has continued to reinvent itself over the years. Currently, the city is experiencing over \$9 billion of redevelopment in the downtown area despite the recession. You will be staying in the heart of all this action. Presentations will cover topics such as Operations, Planning, Safety, and Multi-Modal Transportation. Kansas City is often touted as having almost as many boulevards as Paris and fountains as Rome. Whether you are planning a trip to Kansas City for the conference, live in the area and will be commuting, or want to plan a mini-vacation for the family, there is plenty to do for everyone. If you haven't been to Kansas City lately we hope you are pleasantly surprised by all of the things to do. If you are from the area, we hope to introduce you to something new! And if family members are attending the conference with you, we can provide you additional information on local attractions. Lucky for you, there is enough to do within walking distance or a bus ride away that you will not have to go far to keep yourself entertained.

Just down the street from the Crowne Plaza Hotel, located in the heart of downtown, is the newly constructed Power & Light District, Sprint Center, and the National College Basketball Experience. Next door to your hotel is Kansas City's Municipal Auditorium, which has hosted more NCAA Final Four Championships than any other venue in the country. Barney Allis Plaza is conveniently located across the street from the hotel. At your door step is the MAX bus line, which can take you to other regional destinations such as the Nelson Atkins Museum of Art, Crown Center, and the Country Club Plaza.

Getting Around the City

Driving to Kansas City? We hope you will consider carpooling! Once you get to the conference everything is within walking distance. If you are flying to Kansas City, shuttle service to/from the hotel is available, see the "transportation" section of this packet for additional information. If you live within the Kansas City metro area we encourage you to consider carpooling with co-workers or riding the Metro Area Express (MAX). The MAX bus line is located directly in front of the hotel, providing conference attendees with a safe, inexpensive way to tour Kansas City. With the MAX just outside your doorstep you will find easy access to some of the metro area's hottest destinations. The Plaza, Brookside, Nelson Atkins Museum of Art, WWI Museum, Kemper Museum of Art, Crown Center, and the River Market are only a few steps away.

Parking is available at the hotel or at the Barney Allis Plaza for a small fee.

A room block has been reserved for the MOVITE conference. To get the special room rate your reservation must be received before April 2, 2010. The group rate is \$119 for a standard room (single or double) or \$159 for a suite (single or double). All room rates are plus tax and fees.

TRANSPORTATION

The hotel offers shuttle service between the airport and hotel for a fee. The Super-Shuttle offers one-way or roundtrip airport transfers every 30 minutes from the Crowne Plaza Hotel to/from Kansas City International Airport (MCI). A one-way trip is \$17.00 and a roundtrip is \$29.00. Group rates are available. Offices are located in each terminal at MCI, or reservations can be made via www.kctg.com/super-shuttle or by phone at 1.800.258.3826.

Riding the bus is easy, with a station located directly outside the hotel doors. Fares start at \$1.50. If purchasing a pass on the bus, cash is required. If more than the fare is inserted, you will be provided a change card for use on a future ride, you will not receive cash back. Interested in a day pass? Buy a day pass on the bus for only \$3 and enjoy unlimited rides all day. Or a three-day pass can be purchased for unlimited rides for three days in a row for \$10. GENERAL INFORMATION

PARKING

Parking is available adjacent to the hotel or at the Barney Allis Plaza, located less than a block from the conference site. Parking at the hotel is \$13.00/day or \$10.00/day for overnight guests. Parking is also available at the Barney Allis Plaza parking garage located northwest of the conference site. Parking at this facility is available for \$13.00/day.

ATTIRE

Business casual attire is appropriate for the conference. The Thursday evening entertainment will be held at the College Basketball Experience. To participate in the interactive exhibits appropriate attire is required – athletic shoes are required in the activity venue areas, hard soled shoes are not allowed on the courts. Athletic clothing is recommended. As they say, "WARNING! You may sweat."

DIRECTIONS TO HOTEL



Coming from Airport:

Take I-29 southbound to US-169 southbound. US-169 will turn into Broadway Boulevard. Take Broadway Boulevard to 14th Street. Turn left onto 14th Street. Then turn left on Wyandotte. Hotel is on right.

Coming from South of City:

Take US-71 north to I-670 westbound. Take I-670 westbound to Broadway exit. Take a right on Broadway. Then turn right on 14th Street. Take 14th Street to Wyandotte and turn left. Hotel is on the right.

Coming from East of City:

Take I-70 westbound to 13th Street exit. Take 13th Street to Wyandotte. Turn left on Wyandotte. Hotel is on left.

Coming from Northwest of City:

Take I-29 southbound to US-169 southbound. US-169 will turn into Broadway Boulevard. Take Broadway Boulevard to 14th Street. Turn left onto 14th Street. Then turn left on Wyandotte. Hotel is on right.

Coming from Southwest of City:

Take I-35 from the southwest and take the first Broadway exit on the right. Turn left onto Broadway (northbound) and turn right on 14th Street. Take 14th Street to Wyandotte and turn left. Hotel is on right.

Coming from West of City:

Take I-70 eastbound to I-670. Take I-670 to Central Avenue exit. Turn left onto Central. Turn right onto 14th Street then left onto Wyandotte. Hotel is on the right.


TECHNICAL PROGRAM
